Here is the text: *“For since the creation of the world³ His¹ invisible attributes² are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made⁴, even His¹ eternal power and Godhead², so that they are without excuse⁵”*

- 2) What? Witnessing and knowing about God’s existence and His true nature and power. The evidence and proof is more than abundant.
- 3) When? Since the very beginning – throughout all of time. There has never been a time when people could not know that there is a God.
- 4) Where? Literally everywhere the creation can be seen. It is evident and can be clearly observed and deciphered by all.
- 5) Why? So that we may believe. If we examine all of this evidence and do not believe, then we are without excuse.
